The Iowa Emergency Management Association (IEMA) offers three levels of the Iowa Certified Emergency Manager (IACEM.)

IACEM, designed for knowledgeable program staff with at least two years of experience.

IACEM Advanced, designed for professionals with five or more years of experience.

IACEM Executive, designed for tenured professionals with a wide breadth of knowledge and experience.

COST

The approximate investment for personnel to complete the IACEM level has a value of \$5,000.
